President Franklin Roosevelt died in 1945 after years of struggling over World War II that was nearing its end. The free world mourned and honored his memory on a new coin with his portrait. Since the late President had been afflicted with polio, a seated figure as was the design, was symbolic of the struggle he and people through the "March of Death" following campaign began during Roosevelt's last term.

The reverse features a torch, a symbol of freedom, with olive and oak branches denoting peace and victory. Very few of these were saved in their original Mint issued condition and are scarce items. They have been mounted since 1946.
